- To ensure proper processing of the application, you are required to provide full details of the cause of damage and explain the whereabouts of the missing parts in detail. In providing detailed information and explanations, you will avoid having to answer further questions and therefore unnecessary time and effort in processing the application. A separate sheet may be used if necessary.
