

Auction announcement Reopening of five-year Federal notes (Bundesobligationen – “Bobls”) series 159 by auction

As already announced in the issue calendar for the first quarter of 2011, the Federal Government will reopen once again the

on 2 March 2011, using an auction procedure. An increase of € 5 billion is envisaged for the issue (auction allotment and amount set aside for secondary market operations). The current volume of this series amounts to € 11 billion. Members of the Bund Issues Auction Group are entitled to bid.

Characteristics of the five-year Federal notes:

Maturity: 26 February 2016

Interest payment: annually on 26 February, interest has begun to accrue on 14 January 2011

First interest payment: 26 February 2012 for 408 days
