Announcement of auction Reopening of 10-year Federal bonds

As already announced in the issuance calendar for the fourth quarter of 2013, the Federal Government will reopen once again the

2 % bonds of the Federal Republic of Germany of 2013 (2023)

issued on 11 September 2013 - ISIN DE0001102325 // SIN 110 232

on 30 October 2013, using an auction procedure. An increase of € 4 billion is envisaged for the issue (auction allotment and amount set aside for secondary market operations). The current volume of the bond amounts to € 10 billion. Members of the Bund Issues Auction Group are entitled to bid.

Bidding period: Wednesday, 30 October 2013,
from 8.00 a.m. until 11.30 a.m. Frankfurt time

Terms of the issue to be reopened:

Maturity: 15 August 2023

Interest payment: 15 August annually,
interest has begun to accrue on 15 August 2013

First interest payment: 15 August 2014 for 365 days
