# Announcement of auction Reopening of 10-year Federal bonds

As already announced in the issuance calendar for the fourth quarter of 2013, the Federal Government will reopen once again the

### **2 % bonds of the Federal Republic of Germany of 2013 (2023)**

issued on 11 September 2013 - ISIN DE0001102325 // SIN 110 232

on 27 November 2013, using an auction procedure. An increase of €4 billion is envisaged for the issue (auction allotment and amount set aside for secondary market operations). The current volume of the bond amounts to €14 billion. Members of the Bund Issues Auction Group are entitled to bid.
