## Eurosystem Collateral Management System (ECMS) Agenda



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## ECMS New go-live date confirmed



- The ECB Governing Council has decided to reschedule the launch of the ECMS to 18 November 2024.
- The Governing Council's decision is in line with the view of the Market Infrastructure Board (MIB) that users require more time to complete ECMS functional testing in a stable environment.
- The additional time is intended to ensure
  - ✓ greater system stability,
  - ✓ users' operational readiness,
  - ✓ and facilitate a **smooth migration** to the new platform.

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
#### ECMS User testing: introduction



- **Staggered testing activities**: first NCBs, then CSDs and TPAs, and finally counterparties
- Customer testing in UTEST/Pre-Prod environment
- Duration of the user testing phase: 10 July 2023 to 6 September 2024
- Testing burden greater for future A2A users:
  - Only harmonised, ISO 20022-compliant messages

### **ECMS community testing** Testing phases





 PW(D)R = Preparation week (dress) rehearsal,

## **ECMS community testing** Testing phases



#### Community testing phase 2c:

- Period: 27 November 2023 to 12 April 2024 (testing phase extended by around two months)
- ECMS functionality and process testing with T2S and CLM connectivity

#### Community testing phase 2d (new):

- Period: 15 to 26 April 2024 (period net of migration testing)
- ECMS functionality and process testing without T2S and CLM connectivity
- A **simulator** will be used in this phase.

#### Community testing phase 2e (new):

- Period: 24 June to 6 September 2024
- ECMS functionality and process testing with T2S and CLM connectivity

## **ECMS community testing** Testing phases



#### Business day testing:

- Slot 1: 1 July to 11 July 2024 (except Fridays)
- Slot 2: 26 August to 5 September 2024 (except Fridays)

**Operational testing:** 

- 20 November 2023 to 22 September 2024
- Operational testing is used to validate operational procedures.


Both testing phases run in parallel with customer testing.



#### **Please note:**

The community testing phases also include the **migration testing** mentioned above.

It is not possible to carry out specialist tests in the ECMS during migration testing.



#### **ECMS community testing** Test cases



Bundesbank-defined test cases must be carried out during the community testing phases:

#### - ECMS UT fundamental test cases

- Test cases for counterparties standardised throughout the Eurosystem

- Bundesbank test cases

- Additional test cases defined by the Bundesbank

## ECMS community testing Test sets



All test cases are grouped into test sets.

The following test sets are intended for the counterparties:

- Marketable assets
- Global credit and collateral position
- Cash collateral
- Corporate actions
- Monetary policy operations
- Triparty
- Pool position and projection
- Statement and reporting
- Non-repudiation of origin (NRO) with Ascertia Go>Sign

### **ECMS community testing** Staggered approach



- As decided by the Eurosystem, the functionalities in the ECMS are being gradually released for the institutions to test.
- Counterparties need to wait for the Bundesbank to release the functionalities before testing them.

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### **ECMS community testing** Notes on testing using the 4-eyes principle



- At present, the 4-eyes principle is not working in the ECMS as it should. Tests should therefore be conducted initially using the 2-eyes principle.
- For the time being, please do not create any further users with the role of "validator" (4-eyes principle) in the ECMS.
- Instead, use the "supervalidator" role (2-eyes principle).
- When new users are created, ensure that they are always assigned the "supervalidator" role and a business role. Otherwise, no users can be created.
- We will let you know as soon as the 4-eyes principle is working.

If errors occur when carrying out test cases, proceed as follows:

### **ECMS community testing** Bundesbank support (1/3)



- The Bundesbank will provide support for institutions testing during an allotted test cycle.





**ECMS** Migration phases in the ECMS Prod environment (1/2)



ECMS Prod environment

"Big bang" migration of all Eurosystem NCBs in November 2024: ECMS go-live date: 18 November 2024

#### Migration phases:

- 1. Connectivity set-up and execution including migration of master data part 1, and creation of A2A users and user administrators by the Bundesbank
- 2. Pre-migration phase: migration of the remaining master data and creation of additional users
- 3. Migration weekend: migration of holdings
- 4. Post-migration





- NCBs will migrate all Friday EoD holdings to the ECMS.
- Custodians (CSD accounts) remain unchanged. Using the ECMS, they will simply be managed by a new system.
- Construction of the Prod environment will run in parallel to customer testing in the UTEST/Pre-Prod environment.
- No outstanding transactions on the migration weekend:
  - (De)mobilisations must have been completed by Friday or by the date yet to be announced; otherwise, they must be executed on the following Monday.
  - As things stand now, there is <u>no</u> general requirement for all counterparties to participate.
- Migration phases 2 to 4 are essentially NCB-internal processes. Counterparty participation is needed in terms of creating ECMS users and may be required for reconciliation of reference data in the pre-migration phase. The implications for CSDs and TPAs will be more substantial.





ECMS Prod environment

#### Connectivity set-up and execution phase

- 1. Customer-side preparations must be completed by start of phase: set-up at NSP level, registration form for Prod environment submitted.
- 2. Bundesbank migrates master data required for connectivity and creates the A2A and U2A users named in the registration forms for the ECMS Prod environment with their first DN\* certificate.
- 3. You may only execute activities in the Prod environment that are assigned to you by the Bundesbank.
- 4. Execution of activities assigned by the Bundesbank in the Bundesbank-specified time windows: connectivity expected to start from the beginning of May 2024 after Bundesbank gives go ahead, connectivity testing (U2A, A2A) carried out until 31 May 2024. Please complete these steps promptly.
- Set-up of second DN\* for user administrators set up by Bundesbank, as well as A2A users if desired/required (see slide 34).

\*DN = distinguished name



#### Implementation of one user multiple DNs (change request 0084) when ECMS goes live:

- All users are currently set up with a single DN (U2A and A2A users) in the ECMS UTEST/Pre-Prod environment.
- A software adjustment for the change request in the ECMS will be made available in the customer testing environment in March 2024. After the Bundesbank gives the go ahead, institutions that will use multiple DNs must subsequently record these themselves in the ECMS. This will likely be possible in UTEST between 1 and 26 April 2024 (before migration test 9); adjustments will be possible during migration test 9, but A2A cannot be tested. It is possible that further adjustments will be made after migration test 9.
- Prod environment: similar procedure admin users named in the registration form will be set up with a DN by the Bundesbank, additional DNs will be added by the institution users themselves. This will be possible from the beginning of May to 1 August 2024.
- Note: please (almost) complete the adjustment in UTEST before adding DNs to users in ECMS Prod.



## ECMS Community readiness monitoring – German market



#### Bundesbank-specific survey:

- On 29 January 2024, an ECMS community readiness survey was sent to our contact persons (RMAs\*/CMAs\*).
- The survey focused on **Bundesbank-specific questions**.
- The deadline for responses was Monday, **26 February 2024**.

#### Next ECB community readiness surveys:

- The next surveys on monetary policy counterparties' readiness to **go live with the ECMS** are scheduled for **June** and **September this year**.
- Going forward, **testing and migration** milestones <u>will no longer</u> be surveyed as part of community readiness monitoring, but only via the **existing surveys** on testing status and migration preparations.

## ECMS Community readiness monitoring – German market



Key topics in the current survey:

✓ Assessment of how the project is progressing towards the ECMS going live in November 2024

✓ Feedback on ECMS connectivity

✓ Relevance for the use of CR 0084 (ECMS users with multiple (DN\* = certificates)

✓ Ascertia Go>Sign Desktop Client, version 6.9.0.20

✓ Feedback on whether milestones from earlier reporting cycles have been met

### ECMS ECMS users with multiple DNs (CR 0084)



Thus far, it is not technically possible to connect one ECMS user to multiple (DNs = certificates) in the ECMS.

As a result, it **is not** possible **to** address **multiple gateways** in the ECMS, which means that if one gateway is unavailable, another can be used as a fallback solution.

Example for U2A connectivity:

- An ECMS user has one DN for the Prod SAG\* and another DN for the fallback SAG\*.
- The credit institution would have to decide which DN should be registered in the ECMS for each user. Depending on which gateway (Prod/fallback) might not be available in a given situation, the user may not be able to connect to the ECMS.
- Change request (CR) No 0084 remedies this restriction in the ECMS.
- This CR will be implemented when the ECMS goes live. This means that connectivity with multiple DNs will be implemented in the ECMS test environment UTEST at the beginning of the testing phase in spring 2024.



#### Digital signature (NRO) for critical transactions

- In order to ensure non-repudiation of origin (NRO) for critical transactions, the use of a digital signature has been implemented for certain screens.
- This means that users will be asked to enter a PIN for signature purposes whenever an instruction is initiated. With the entry of the PIN, the ECMS attaches a digital signature to the instruction entered by the user.
- Users will have to install Ascertia Go>Sign Desktop Client, version 6.9.0.20 on their workstation in order to be able to use the ECMS via U2A for screens subject to a digital signature.
- Ascertia is the single NRO solution for all TARGET Services. In other words, the same version of the Ascertia Go>Sign Desktop client is used for the various TARGET Services.
- To ensure that participation in ECMS testing runs smoothly, we recommend that you install the software in good time. All
  users who are authorised to access the ESMIG portal can download it.


