Announcement of a multi-ISIN auction Reopening of three Federal bonds

On 15 July 2026 the following Federal bonds will be reopened by a multi-ISIN auction:

0 % bond of the Federal Republic of Germany of 2021 (2052)

ISIN DE0001102572

Maturity: 15 August 2052

Current volume : € 37 billion

2.50 % bond of the Federal Republic of Germany of 2024 (2054)

ISIN DE000BU2D004

Maturity: 15 August 2054

Current volume : € 29 billion

2.90 % bond of the Federal Republic of Germany of 2025 (2056)

ISIN DE000BU2D012

Maturity: 15 August 2056

Current volume : € 28.5 billion

An increase of € 3 billion in total is envisaged for the reopening of all bonds (including respective retention quote) with a planned share of € 1 billion for the 0 % bond of the Federal Republic of Germany of 2021 (2052), ISIN DE0001102572, € 1 billion for the 2.50 % bond of the Federal Republic of Germany of 2024 (2054), ISIN DE000BU2D004, and € 1 billion for the 2.90 % bond of the Federal Republic of Germany of 2025 (2056), ISIN DE000BU2D012. The effective increase of each bond will be determined by the allotment on 15 July 2026.

Members of the Bund Issues Auction Group are entitled to bid. Bids must be for a par value of not less than € 1 million or an integral multiple thereof. The price bids must be expressed in terms of full 0.01 percentage points. Non-competitive bids are possible. The bids accepted by the issuer will be allotted at the price specified in the bid. Non-competitive bids are filled at the weighted average price of the competitive bids accepted. The right to scale down bids is reserved.
